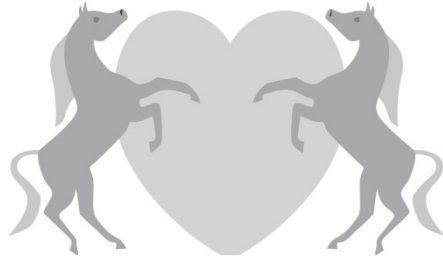

NB. Exhibitors should bring their own tools, forks, brooms, barrows etc for mucking out

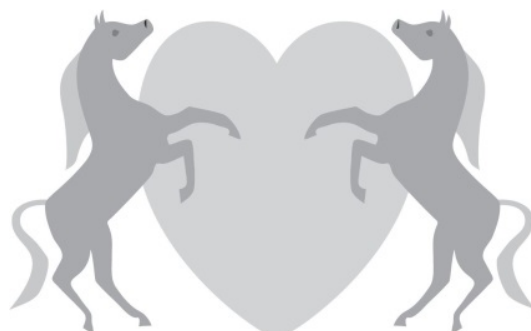

IN-HAND PALOMINO CHAMPIONSHIP

(1st & 2nd from classes 18-21)

For Palominos registered with the British Palomino Society and owned by a paid-up member of the society. These classes are affiliated to the BPS and are run under BPS rules, please refer to www.thebritishpalominosociety.co.uk. BPS Colour awards to be presented in in-hand classes these qualify for the Golden Trail Championship.

The winner of each BPS Affiliated class will qualify for the NEW Palomino of the Year Championship, Final to be held at the BPS Autumn Show. See website for details.

LIGHT HORSE CLASSES

- CLASS 22** Best 1, 2 or 3yo light horse expected to exceed 148 cm at maturity
- CLASS 23** Best light horse 4yo and over exceeding 148 cms

LIGHT HORSE CHAMPIONSHIP

(1st & 2nd from classes 22 & 23)

CLASS 24 AMATEUR HANDLER

Open to Pure, Anglo and Part-bred Arabians. Any age. Will be split if entries warrant.

Not before 1pm

CLASS 25 GOLDEN OLDIES - in hand.

Open to Pure, Anglo and Part-bred Arabians. Horse and handler must have a combined age of 60+ on the day of the show

CLASS 26 YOUNG HANDLER

Open to Pure and Part-Bred Arabian Mares and Geldings and handled by a junior aged 16 years or under on the day of the show . To be judged on turnout and handlers ability.

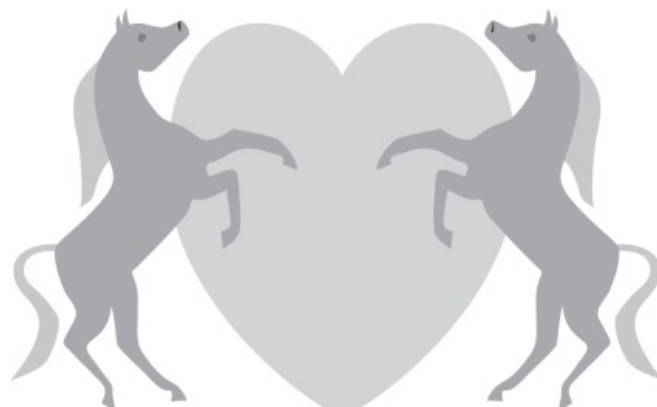
CLASS 27 BEST CRABBET BRED ARABIAN (75% +) 1,2 or 3yo
To be shown in-hand.

CLASS 28 BEST CRABBET BRED ARABIAN (75% +) 4yo and over
To be shown in-hand.

Crabbet Championship
(1st & 2nd from classes 27 & 28)

No late entries for classes 27 & 28

A copy of a Heritage Certificate issued by the Crabbet Organisation Ltd or evidence from the Crabbet organisation that the percentage of Crabbet blood equals or exceeds 75% will be required with each entry. All horses forward **MUST** be shown naturally – in the more traditional manner. Any unnatural posing, flicking with a whip or circling when being run out, will result in the horse being judged as though no presentation or display had been possible, and therefore penalised accordingly. The horses placed first & second in this class will qualify for the National Crabbet In-Hand Championships to be held at the AHS UK National Championships at Malvern in July 2019.



Ring 2 8.30am

CLASS 29 PRE-NOVICE PURE-BRED, PART-BRED or ANGLO-ARAB STALLION MARE OR GELDING

4 years old and over. To be judged as a riding horse. The judge will not ride the horses. Riders will give a short individual show. Horses must not have been placed first more than twice at an affiliated show and may not enter open classes at this show. Four year olds to be shown in a snaffle bridle, Winning a pre-novice class does not affect Novice Status. No spurs to be worn.

NOVICE RIDDEN CLASSES

A Novice horse is one that has not been placed first in three ridden classes at novice or open level at affiliated shows prior to 1 January of the current season and/or has never been awarded champion in a qualifier for THE HORSE OF THE YEAR SHOW.

- CLASS 30** NOVICE RIDDEN PURE-BRED ARABIAN STALLION 4 years old and over. To be judged as a riding horse.
- CLASS 31** NOVICE RIDDEN PURE-BRED ARABIAN GELDING 4 years old and over. To be judged as a riding horse.
- CLASS 32** NOVICE RIDDEN PURE-BRED ARABIAN MARE 4 years old and over. To be judged as a riding horse.
- CLASS 33** NOVICE RIDDEN ANGLO/PART-BRED ARAB 4 years old and over. To be judged as a riding horse

NOVICE RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP (1st & 2nd from Classes 30 to 33)

OPEN RIDDEN PURE-BRED CLASSES

- CLASS 34** RIDDEN PURE-BRED STALLIONS 4 years old and over. Riders must have attained their 14th birthday by 1st Jan in the current year.

CLASS 37 OPEN RIDDEN ANGLO/PART-BRED ARAB 4 years old and over exceeding 148 cm. To be judged as a riding horse.

CLASS 38 OPEN RIDDEN ANGLO/PART-BRED ARAB 4 years old and over 148 cm and under. To be judged as a riding horse.

ANGLO/PART-BRED ARAB RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP

(1st & 2nd from classes 37 & 38)

CLASS 39 MIDLAND ARAB GROUP Ltd NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP FOR YOUNG RIDERS 2019 Qualifying Class

Best Ridden Pure, Part-bred or Anglo-Arab **MARE or GELDING** 4 yrs old and over, suitable for and to be ridden by a Young Rider. This show is a qualifier for the Midland Arab Group Ltd National Championship for Young Riders 2019 for riders up to age 21 years on 1st Jan in the current year. Horses and ponies **will not** be ridden by the judge, but give a short individual show and may be stripped. The two highest placed unqualified animals in the class will qualify. Qualifying cards will be presented in the ring.

NB. The HORSE is being judged for its suitability as a YOUNG RIDERS MOUNT NOT the rider. The final will be held at Arab Horse Society National Championship Show at Malvern on Saturday 27th July 2019, presentation to be in the main ring.

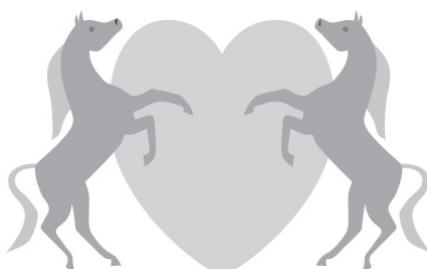
CLASS 40 AMATEUR RIDER CLASS

Best ridden Anglo/Part bred Arab 4 years old and over to be ridden by an amateur, the judge will not ride the horses.

CLASS 41 AMATEUR RIDER CLASS

Best ridden Pure bred Arab 4 years old and over to be ridden by an amateur, the judge will not ride the horses.

(NB. Classes 40 and 41 will be combined if insufficient entries)



This is a qualifying Show for The British Arabian Championships 2019.

Qualification for the BRITISH ARABIAN CHAMPIONSHIPS is via Gold Card, which is awarded to 1st and 2nd prize-winners in Arab Horse Society affiliated classes. Completed Gold Cards should be returned within 10 days of the qualifying show with a cheque for £15 or returned before 20th August with a cheque for £30.

Cheques should be made payable to The Arab Horse Society. Completed cards to be returned to Arab Horse Society, Charnham Lane, Hungerford RG17 OEY

The British Arabian Championship has classes for both in hand and ridden purebred and Part-bred Arabians. (5 height classes).

Once a horse or pony has qualified for the 2019 Championship they may enter any of the classes at the show.

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE SHOW

1. Classes 1 – 12 are run under ECAHO Rules (Blue Book 2019). This Show is affiliated to the Arab Horse Society (Aff. No. 300119) and classes 1 to 12 are governed by their rules.
3. All Exhibits must be registered in their respective Stud Books
4. ALL ENTRIES TO BE ACCOMPANIED BY PHOTOCOPY OF REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE (Both sides).
- 5 NO person other than Show Officials & Sponsors are allowed in Show Ring at any time.
6. 1st & 2nd prizewinners to present themselves for appropriate championship.
7. No claims can be entertained for anything that may happen to competitors, onlookers or their property, employees or animals in connection with, or arising from this show.
8. Any objection that may arise must be promptly lodged with the Secretary accompanied by a £40 deposit-which will be returned if objection upheld.
9. The Judge's decision is final
10. All trophies to be returned to the Secretary **1 month** prior to date of next year's Show. All trophies must be signed for.
11. Depending on the number of entries received, classes may be divided amalgamated or cancelled at the Show's discretion.
- 12. NO OUTSIDE INTERFERENCE EITHER PHYSICAL OR VOCAL IS ALLOWED.**

13. Any horse that leaves the ring after entering for judging, or before the end of the class will be counted as eliminated. Any rider falling off in the class will be eliminated from that class and must leave the ring without remounting.
14. All Stallions or colts over three years old must be bitted.
- 15. HARD HATS MUST BE WORN while riding. See page 3**
16. Age of all exhibits will date from 1st January in year of birth.
17. ENTRY FEES CANNOT BE REFUNDED.
18. In the interests of safety and enjoyment of the Show, the Committee reserves the right to refuse entries from any person failing to comply with the requests of the judges, officials, officers, stewards/assistants in car/lorry parks, stables or show rings.
19. The Organisers have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health & safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective EVERYONE must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring.
20. Any exhibitor occupying stabling not allocated to them will not be allowed to compete.

The ECAHO Disciplinary Committee is responsible for enforcing the ECAHO Rules and the Show Organiser is responsible for enforcing the AHS Rules.

This Show is affiliated to the Arab Horse Society and to the European Conference of Arab Horse Organisations. The rules of both organisations apply to classes 1 to 12 ECAHO Rules taking precedence where there could be a clash or conflict. Classes 13 onwards fall outside the jurisdiction of ECAHO and only the AHS Rules apply to them. The ECAHO Disciplinary Committee is responsible for enforcing the ECAHO rules.
